Brand's east territory, he opted to rejoin Coca-Cola as general manager of Sonic business in 2006. He was promoted to his current position in June 2010.

He received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from Union College in Schenectady, NY. He also holds a Master of Public Affairs degree in International Affairs from Columbia University in New York, NY.
